Definition

An data element is a [characteristic](#) of an [entity type](#).

Synonym(s)

- Attribute
- Field
- Column
- Property

Note(s)

Another definition is: A data element (DE) is a unit of data that is considered in context to be indivisible (ISO 11179:2015). However, this may also indicate a [data item](#).

A data element is specified by its name, definition, classification and [format](#).

Relation(s)

[critical data element](#), [data element specification](#)

Example(s)

Examples of data elements are:

- Employee name
- Employee date of birth
- Employee function name
