

Unit

Definition

Unit is a standard quantity used to express and compare measurements of a particular physical quantity.

Note

Unit provides a reference point or scale for measuring the magnitude of that quantity. Units allow us to quantify and communicate measurements in a consistent and universally understood manner.

Relations

Unit	is instance of	quantity
Unit	is subtype of	metadata

Examples

- Quantity length: meters, miles, foot.
- Quantity volume: liters, gallons.
- Quantity temperature: Celcius, Fahrenheit, Kelvin
