Data modeling is a step in the lifecycle of [data](#) that results in a [data model](#).

Data Modeling is the process of discovering, analyzing, and scoping data requirements, and then representing and communicating these data requirements in a precise form called the [data model](#). This process is iterative and may include a conceptual, logical, and physical model.
