Accessibility

Definition

Accessbility of data is the degree to which the user is able to access and use data.

Notes

- Accesibility involves ensuring that data is stored in a format that is compatible with the tools and applications that will be used to work with it.
- Accessibility also includes ensuring that appropriate permissions and security protocols are in place to control who has access to the data.

Relation(s)

- Accessibility is a characteristic of data.
- Accessiblity is preceded by findability. You have to be able to find the data first, to know if they are accessible.
- Accessibility is one of the three aspects of data security: confidentiality, integrity, and accessibility (CIA).
