Definitions

Comparability of **data values over populations** is the degree to which **data values** representing two or more **populations** have the same definition and are measured in the same way.

Comparability of **data values over time** is the degree to which **data values** over time have the same definition and are measured in the same way.

Relations

Comparability is a characteristic of **data values**

Examples

- Comparability of sales figures in different areas.
- Comparability of sales figures over the years.
