

# Confidentiality

## Definition

Confidentiality of [data](#) is the degree to which disclosure of data is restricted to authorized [data users](#).

## Relations

Confidentiality	is <a href="#">characteristic</a> of	<a href="#">data</a>
Confidentiality	is one of three aspects of	<a href="#">data security</a>

Other aspects are [integrity](#) and [accessibility](#) (CIA).

- Confidentiality is a [characteristic](#) of [data](#).
- Confidentiality is one of the three aspects of [data security](#) next to [integrity](#) and [accessibility](#) (CIA).
