Definition

Linkability of data files is the degree to which [data records](#) of one [data file](#) can be correctly coupled with [data records](#) of another [data file](#).

Relation(s)

Linkability is a [characteristic](#) of [data files](#).

Example

95% of the incoming invoices can be linked to suppliers in the supplier database.
