Definitions

Portability of <u>data</u> is the degree to which <u>data</u> can be installed, replaced or moved from one system to another while preserving the existing quality.

Portability of a <u>format</u> is the degree to which a <u>format</u> can be applied in a wide range of situations.

Relation(s)

Portability is a characteristic of data and format.

Example(s)

These data are portible and can be exchanged with other personal computers.

ASCII is a very portible format.
