

Punctuality

Definition

Punctuality of data availability is the degree to which the period between the actual and target point of time of [availability of the dataset](#) is appropriate.

Relation(s)

Punctuality is a [characteristic](#) of the [availability of a dataset](#).

Example(s)

The data supplier had agreed to deliver the data by 12 March. He was punctual as the delivery took place on 10 March.
