

# Reproducibility

## Definition

Reproducibility of a data set is the degree to which a [dataset](#) can be recreated with the same [data values](#).

## Relations

Reproducibility	is a	<a href="#">characteristic</a>	of a	<a href="#">dataset</a>
-----------------	------	--------------------------------	------	-------------------------

## Examples

The file of suppliers got lost but could be reproduced based on a printed list of suppliers.
