

# Timeliness

## Definition

Timeliness of data availability is the degree to which the period between the time of creation of the **real value** and the time that the **dataset is available** is appropriate.

## Note(s)

Note the difference with **punctuality** which refers to a planned point in time of delivery.

## Relation(s)

Timeliness is a **characteristic** of the **availability** of a dataset.

## Example(s)

The annual report over 2022 became available at 15 January 2023. The timeliness of the report was more than appropriate.
