

# Timeliness

## Definition

Timeliness of data availability is the degree to which the period between the time of creation of the [real value](#) and the time that the [dataset is available](#) is appropriate.

## Note

Note the difference with [punctuality](#) which refers to a planned point in time of delivery.

## Relation

Timeliness is a <a href="#">characteristic</a> of the <a href="#">availability of a dataset</a>

## Example(s)

The annual report over 2022 became available at 15 January 2023. The timeliness of the report was more than appropriate.
