Traceability of data is the degree to which it is possible to trace how the [data](#) was created.

Note(s)

If data are traceable it means [data lineage](#) is available.

Relations

Traceability is a [characteristic](#) of a [data](#).

Example(s)

The data could be traced from input through the process until the output.
