Definition

Traceability of data is the degree to which it is possible to trace how [data](#) was created.

Note

If data are traceable it means that [data lineage](#) is available.

Relation

Traceability	is a characteristic of	data
Traceability	is promoted by	data lineage

Example

The data could be traced from input through the process until the output.
