Corrective action

Definition

Corrective action is an action to eliminate the cause of data issues.

Relations

- A corrective action is a subtype of action.
- A corrective action is implemented in response to a correction.
- A corrective action prevents data issues respectively eliminated the cause of data issues.
- Corrective action is taken to prevent <u>recurrence</u> whereas <u>preventive action</u> is taken to prevent <u>occurrence</u>.

Example

Implementing a data quality rule in which the adress is derived from the zipcode instead of the user entering the address
