

Corrective action

Definition

Corrective action is an [action](#) to eliminate the cause of [data issues](#).

Relations

- A corrective action is a subtype of [action](#).
- A corrective action is implemented in response to a [correction](#).
- A corrective action prevents [data issues](#) respectively eliminated the cause of [data issues](#).
- Corrective action is taken to prevent [recurrence](#) whereas [preventive action](#) is taken to prevent [occurrence](#).

Example

Implementing a [data quality rule](#) in which the adress is derived from the zipcode instead of the user entering the address
