Definition

Data quality is [quality](#) with regard to [data](#).

DMBoK2

Data Quality is the extent to which the data meets the business needs; data that 'fully' meets user requirements.

DDDM

The degree to which data is accurate, complete, timely, consistent with all requirements and business rules, and relevant for a given use.

Relation

Data quality	is child of	quality
Data quality	has multiple	data quality dimensions

- Assess data quality
- Profile data quality
- Assure data quality, according to the [data quality requirements](#).
- Monitor data quality ([data quality monitoring](#))
- Evaluate data quality
- Audit data quality
- Improve data quality
