Definition DMBOK2

Data [governance](#) is the exercise of authority and control (planning, monitoring, and enforcement) over the [management](#) of data assets (DAMA-DMBOK, 2017).

Other definitions are:

- Data governance is the cross-functional discipline of managing, improving, monitoring, maintaining, and protecting data (Askham).
- Data Governance is a collection of processes, roles, standards, and metrics that ensure the effective and efficient use of information in enabling an organisation to achieve its goals (Askham).
