Definition

Quality is the degree to which a [thing](#) meets the requirements.

DDDM

- The degree to which a set of inherent characteristics fulfills requirements. Quality is a multi-faceted concept. The dimensions of quality that are considered most important depend on user perspectives, needs and priorities, which vary across groups of users.
- Adjective. In common use, of or having superior or high quality, or being perceived as superior, without specific qualification.
- A peculiar and essential character, the degree of some characteristic meeting expectations. Quality is defined through four virtues – clarity, elegance, simplicity, and value.
