This page format is used for all wiki pages, if applicable. Headings without corresponding text can be deleted.

Example: Apple tree

First letter of the first term uppercase. The rest lowercase.

Definition

An apple tree is a [tree](#) {parent} that bears [apples](#) {factors that distinguishes a apple tree from other trees}.
